MATRIC NSC RESULTS 2009

The 2009 Matric group have done themselves and College proud by producing excellent results in their Final Examination. Timothy Abel was our top candidate by aggregate, and Justin Swart was placed in the IEB top 56 candidates nationally (he achieved in the top 5% of all his subjects). We congratulate both boys on their outstanding achievements.

We have pleasure in summarising the results below:

- 90 candidates achieved 128 distinctions (indicated as NSC rating 7)
- 47% of the subject results were either "A"s or "B"s.
- 84 boys (93%) achieved entry to Degree study, whilst 6 candidates achieved entry to Diploma courses at tertiary level.
- Special mention should be made of Mathematics where 25 of the 71 candidates achieved above 80%.
- 15 boys got their NSC with Distinction
- 37 boys achieved their NSC with Merit.

Boys who achieved 4, or more, subject "A"s (including Mathematics Paper 3) are as follows:

- 7 subject "A"s – Timothy Abel and Justin Swart
- 6 subjects "A"s – Andrew de Blocq van Scheltinga, Jaco Delpport, Robert Hart and Thomas Niven
- 5 subject "A"s – Nicholas Hops, Craig McCune and Luke Westensee
- 4 subject "A"s – Andrew Alexander, Bruce Austin, Jack Darby, Nicholas Hall, Justus Luttig, James McLean, Nathan Meyer, Ross Thompson and Tyrone Wang

Congratulations to the teachers of DSG and College for their dedication and care in preparing these boys over the past five years.
