The 2010 Matric group have rounded off a memorable year at College by producing excellent results in their Final Examination. We warmly congratulate Jordan Maze who made the IEB Outstanding Achievers list for being placed in the top 5% in the country in 6 subjects. Only 65 of the 8 076 candidates who wrote the IEB Examinations made this list. He also achieved a full house of 8 distinctions.

We have pleasure in summarising the results below:

- All 104 candidates who wrote the examination passed, and achieved 145 subject distinctions.
- 220 B symbols were achieved.
- Special mention should be made of the following departments:
 - Mathematics, where 26 of the 80 candidates achieved above 80%
 - Dramatic Art, in which 10 of the 19 boys achieved above 80%
 - Physical Science, in which 11 of the 57 boys achieved above 80%
 - Life Sciences, where 11 of the 48 boys got above 80%.
- 96% of the Matrics qualify to apply to University for Degree courses. The IEB national average is 82%.
- 75% of all the subject results were above 60%
- More than half the boys (55%) got one or more subject distinctions

We also congratulate the following boys who were placed in the top 1% of all the candidates nationally who wrote these subjects:

- Richard Wilson in Mathematics and Mathematics Paper 3
- Breff Whitehead in English Home Language and Mathematics
- Thokozani Ngculu in isiXhosa First Additional Language
- Christopher Weimann in Mathematical Literacy

While we salute the top candidates, the entire group is to be commended, as many of these boys achieved the best examination results of their school careers.

The excellent results reflect the hard work of the candidates and the dedication of the teachers at both the DSG and College.

We wish the Class of 2010 everything of the best as they embark on the next exciting phase of their lives. We are optimistic that they will enjoy excellent careers at tertiary level and beyond.
